At the Pottery Studio, we indulge in social pottery making. It is perfect for a beginner, someone returning to clay or people just looking for a fun night out with a difference. During the 2 hours you can expect to make something and underglaze it so that it will have colour in the finished item. We bisque then glaze fire your piece using a clear glaze which highlights the underglaze colours applied. We use a stoneware clay and foodsafe glazes so your item can be used to drink from or eat off as well as holding either food or water. We have a theme most nights but participants are not required to make the items suggested. If you have a particular thing you wish to make, let us know and we will do our best to help you. We hand build, predominantly using the rolled slab and former method. Partly because of kiln space, we recommend smaller, beautifully made pieces rather than large flat or tall items as these take a lot longer to proceed through the firing process.
